Successful Greta Heritage Afternoon

Approximately 45 locals, visitors & former residents attended the Greta Heritage afternoon on Sunday Nov. 20, 2011 at the Greta-Hansonville Hall. The focus was on three areas of interest: names for an honour board commemorating district service personnel, information about the original district primary schools & stories about the establishment the Greta-Hansonville Recreation Reserve after the 1952 fires destroyed the Hansonville Hall. The afternoon was the first opportunity for the Heritage Group to establish a resources register of what collections exist in the community. The group is also working towards supplying families with a DVD copy of their collections in the near future.

Sincere thanks go to Bob & Georgina Cusack of the Wangaratta Family History Society who volunteered to bring the society's new scanning equipment out to Greta. Thank you too to Val Brennan for 'behind the scenes' organization, also to Shirley Lloyd and Val McMonigle who prepared & served afternoon tea. A highlight of the afternoon was Colin Graham's story regarding the sale of the judge's box used at the Greta Races & its subsequent modification & daily use by the Graham family. Allan Porker recorded several interviews including one with Bob Fry who assisted with the shifting of the Greta Hall to its present site in 1954. Bob's job "was to hold up the power lines!"

Copies of events recorded in the Benalla & Wangaratta newspapers were displayed around the hall walls, creating much interest for senior residents. George & Lorna Hillas were thrilled to receive the 1954 report of their welcome to the district after their marriage & June Larkin (nee Tanner) was surprised to find a report of the "Greta Younger Set" which raised money to fund soldiers Christmas parcels during WW11.

A continuing mystery is what happened to the Greta District Honour Board, formerly in the Hansonville School. Any updates on 'last seen in the storeroom' would be gratefully received. Noeleen Lloyd & Adrian Younger are currently researching prior to establishing a replacement Honour Board. Protocols for inclusion are strict but the Heritage Group expects obtaining a grant for the board will be comparatively easy.

This year another heritage afternoon is proposed for **Sunday**, **March 25**^{th.} A focus for the day has not yet been chosen but it will be just 60 years since fire swept through the Greta district with resultant loss of life, homes, stock & property. Any information on this disastrous event would certainly be welcome. Mark the date in your diary & watch the Bunyip & local papers for more information.

The Heritage Group invites people who are interested in the story of our community to keep in touch & become involved. Let us know your ideas so that together we can work to ensure the valuable past & present heritage of this district is recorded & celebrated.




FIFTEEN MILE CREEK CAMP, GRETA SOUTH

Everybody knows 15 Mile Creek Camp. It's where you went in grade three and first conquered the flying fox, and where you sat in grade 4, getting drenched under your carefully constructed bush hut as a ruthless teacher poured water over the roof to see how well you had made it.

15 Mile Creek is still where it's always been, nestled between Spring Creek, Middle Creek, and of course, its namesake 15 Mile Creek. But in the last two years lots of changes have been happening in this quiet corner of Greta South. 15 Mile Creek is no longer just a camp. We've teamed up with Bogong Outdoor Education Centre, to become a multi-campus outdoor residential school. Outdoor residential school? That means that 15 Mile Creek has been funded by the Department of Education to resource our campus so that students from all state schools can come to 15 Mile Creek and make the bush their classroom as they explore and learn in the outdoors.

This new structure has been in place since the start of 2010. With help and mentoring from our more established campus and a dedicated staff of 8 teachers and 6 education support staff, 15 Mile Creek will continue to grow and develop, so we can educate and inspire Victorian students for many more generations.
