GRETA VALLEY LANDCARE GROUP

Landcare at the Moyhu Garden Expo – Greta Valley Landcare members with the assistance of the Society for Australian Plants will be providing plant propagation demonstrations and advice at the Garden Expo on October the 19th. Come along and say hello to the members at the Landcare Trailer.

Landcare end of year dinner will be held at the Myrree Recreation Reserve on Saturday the 23rd of November. Local indigenous elder, Wally Cooper will present stories of the district and share his local knowledge on bush foods, plants and wildlife. The evening will feature a BBQ dinner including indigenous and bush foods.

Roadside pest plants and animals control program. The Rural City of Wangaratta annually supports Greta Valley Landcare to coordinate locally prioritised pest plant and animal control. In recent years we have targeted cactus and isolated patches of emerging weeds in the area. This year we are asking the community to provide feedback to the committee on where you would like to see more work done. Please make contact with the secretary if you are aware of any locations or species that seem to have fallen through the cracks.
