## Smart Farms, Small Grants, Round 3 – More shade and shelter funding for 2021 *Project: Establishing the building blocks for resilient farming communities*

We were thrilled to have been notified that we have been granted \$44 000 to continue our work on shade and shelter in our catchment in 2021. The funding includes provision for two workshops:

- Climate web based forecast tools, including soil moisture probe network
- Introduction to regenerative agriculture, including demonstration of our new Yeomans Keyline plough (currently being built, coming soon!)

This project is supported by funding from the Australian Government's National Landcare Program.

### WIRES - Landcare Wildlife Relief and Recovery Grant 2020

### Project: Enhancing habitat on Fifteen Mile Creek

This week we received notification that we have received \$20000 towards a weed control program targeting invasive weeds (willow and cape broom) on Fifteen Mile Creek between Myrrhee and Greta South. We will also be able to provide shrubs to landholders to enhance habitat for species from our threatened woodland bird community.

The Committee will soon be meeting via Zoom to discuss the roll out of this program, so stay tuned in future newsletters for an Expression of Interest process and what we can offer landholders.
