CEMETERY TRUST NEWS

The Greta Valley Landcare Group are striding forward with a number of committee members taking on extra roles now Sally has moved on.

GRANTS

The group has been successful in gaining two grants. \$5000 of funding has been granted from the Gardiner Foundation under its community grants program, delivered collaboratively with Foundation for Rural Regional Renewal, aimed at supporting not-for-profit organisations in dairy regions of Victoria. These funds will be used to continue development of the Moyhu walking track. The Victorian Government Landcare program has allocated \$20,000 to our group for future projects, largely revegetation.

TREE PLANTING

A reminder to members who have planted trees and shrubs this season, to take clear photos of the plantings so we can supply these as part of our reporting for the public funding you have received.

We also need to know the location of your planting. Please supply the address of your site or put a pin or screen shot of the planting location in Google Maps.

Remember to return the pots and pot trays directly to Park Lane Nursery in Wangaratta so they can be reused.

Water your plants as the conditions warm up.

The group is still hoping for a volunteer to either take on or share administration for the Greta Valley Landcare Group and projects.

TREE GUARDS

We have another batch of large mesh tree guards available to members for \$40 GST inclusive per guard.

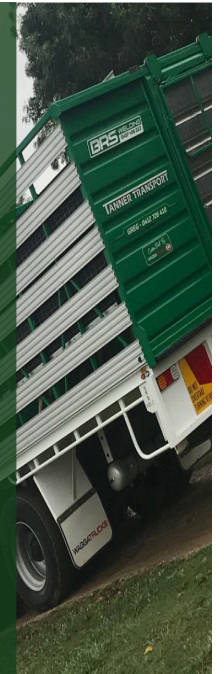
